DEFINING CARE, LOYALTY, & OBEDIENCE

- <u>Duty of Care:</u> Board members are expected to actively participate in organizational planning and decision-making and to make sound and informed judgments.
- Duty of Loyalty: Requires the board member to operate in the interest of the organization and not to use the position to further personal agenda.
- Duty of Obedience: Requires Board members accept and follow the mission of the organization, the laws that govern nonprofit taxexempt organizations, and any legal documents the organization and the Board have adopted and instituted—articles of incorporation, bylaws, policies, resolutions, etc.
