

Grant Acronyms & FY24 Funding

- PADD: Protection and Advocacy for Individuals with Developmental Disabilities
 \$414,977 FY2024 grant + \$127,441 carryover = \$542,418 Total
- PAIMI: Protection and Advocacy for Individuals with Mental Illness
 - \$473,700 FY2024 grant + \$193,268 carryover = \$666,968 Total
- PAIR: Protection and Advocacy for Individual Rights
 - \$195,895 FY2024 grant + \$46,100 carryover = \$241,995 Total
- **PABSS:** Protection and Advocacy for Beneficiaries of Social Security
 - \$123,965 FY2024 grant + \$78,107 carryover = **\$202,072** Total
- **PATBI:** Protection and Advocacy for Individuals with Traumatic Brain Injury
 - \$50,000 FY2024 grant + \$14,161 carryover = \$64,161 Total
- PAVA: Protection and Advocacy for Voting Access
 \$141,043 FY2024 grant + \$273,413 carryover = \$414,456 Total
- PAAT: Protection and Advocacy Assistive Technology
 - \$43,250 FY2023 sub-award = **\$43,250** Total (FY2024 award to DRI = \$50,000
- **Rep Payee:** Rep Payee: Strengthening Protections for Social Security Beneficiaries
 - \$265,680 FY2024 grant + \$31,898 carryover = \$297,578 Total (Aug Jul Fiscal Year)
- WIPA: Work Incentives Planning Assistance
 - \$276,700 FY2024 grant + \$18,248 carryover = \$294,948 Total (Jul Jun Fiscal Year)
- **PAPH:** Protection and Advocacy for Expanding the Public Health Workforce
 - \$66,993 Total (1 time grant with runway through 9/30/2024)

Notes on Increases:

Final award amounts for all grants are still not fully known due to Congress. Amounts in **blue** are best estimates based on last year's funding.

The most likely outcome is level funding, but a slight decrease is possible. An increase is extremely unlikely.

WIPA and Rep Payee are well into their FY24 grant years due to the timing of their fiscal years.





• Total Accrual Revenue through 12/31/2023 is \$475k vs. budget of \$522k.




<u>Notes</u>

General Activity– PAVA spending will increase beginning in January with elections. PABSS is picking up and our WIPA team will be spending more time in PABSS in 2024. Need PAAT activity to increase and plans are being developed to accomplish this. Spending in other areas is good considering two positions are currently being filled.

Expenses



• Total Accrual Expense through 12/31/2023 is \$476k vs. budget of \$530k.



<u>Notes</u>

- Salaries & Wages Variance is due to an open Attorney position and an open Legal Assistant position. Both are actively being recruited.
- Staff Development Conferences and development opportunities occur more in the summer months. We also budget high in this category to allow for unexpected trainings that arise.
- Health Insurance Among the most difficult items to budget, DRI takes a conservative approach. This combined with staff vacancies and elections, or lack thereof, of new employees has led to a positive variance.

Attorney Fees


- \$2,500 PADD received for settlement in S. Smith case.

Unrestricted Funds



- \$272 Donations received from October to December 2023.
- \$510,962 December 31st balance of DRI's Unrestricted Funds made up of balances in the Unrestricted Checking Account, interest-bearing Unrestricted Money Market, Certificate of Deposit and Community Foundation of Greater Des Moines investment.
 - This uses the 9/30/2023 balance of the Community Foundation of Greater Des Moines investment due to the timing of its statements. Using the estimated balance shown online, this amount is closer to \$540,000 as of 12/31/23.
