

Medicaid Matters for All Iowans

- More than 700,000 Iowans rely upon Medicaid for essential healthcare services.¹
 That's more than 20% of all Iowans.
- Medicaid pays for 38% of all births in Iowa.²
- Medicaid covers more than 300,000 children across the state.3
- More than 90,000 lowans with disabilities receive coverage through Medicaid.4
- Medicaid is the primary source of payment for 50% of all nursing home residents.⁵
- More than 180,000 Iowans receive Medicaid thanks to the Iowa Health and Wellness Plan, Iowa's Medicaid expansion program.⁶

Medicaid Matters for Iowa's State Budget

- 52% of the federal funding Iowa receives is for Medicaid. This is more than 5 billion dollars annually.⁷
- Proposed cuts to Medicaid would result in a loss of more than 8 billion dollars to lowa over the course of the next nine years.⁸

Medicaid Matters in Iowa's First Congressional District

- Medicaid provides essential cover for 145,955 constituents in Iowa's First Congressional District.
- The First Congressional District stands to lose \$1.83 billion if Congress passes the proposed Medicaid cuts.
- 47,000 lowans in the First Congressional District will lose their Medicaid coverage.
