In Person versus Absentee

## There are Two Main Ways to Vote in Iowa

### In Person:

- Go to your precinct's polling place and vote traditionally
- Vote curbside by driving to your polling place and calling the county auditor or sending someone into the polling place
- Vote early at your county auditor's office up to 29 days before the election

### Absentee:

- Vote at a satellite station, call your county auditor for a list of satellite stations
- Vote by mail-in ballot, request one from your county auditor or fill out the request form on the Secretary of State's website

*Voters can request accommodations at any time during the registration or voting process. In order to have assistance voting, the voter must sign an Affidavit Requesting Assistance*
